Mr. Geller gave a detailed update on the Revised November Budget 2014-2015 for both school and daycare. Both budget reports are filed with the school.

Some points noted:

- Enrolment down this year by ~7%
- Anticipated Total Revenue for School is \$75,184 and for Daycare is \$458,785
- Cuts in revenue particularly noted when comparing Actual 2013-2014 Budget with Revised November Budget for 2014-2015 included:
